

CONSULTATION ON ROAD CLOSURE AT ARDENE VET. OBJECTIONS CLOSING DATE 24 MARCH 2020

*****Your participation is important if you have any concerns about this proposal*****

A944 – Proposed closure of central reservation that allows vehicles to turn right from/to access road that currently serves Ardene House Veterinary Practice/Hospital

Planning consent has been provided for the construction of three class 3 (food and drink) units, including two with 'drive-thru' facilities, on land adjacent to the A944 and Ardene House Veterinary Practice / Hospital.

A condition of the consent is that access will only be provided by way of a left in /left out arrangement, thereby allowing the gap in the central reservation to be closed; the gap concerned currently allows right turn movements from/to the access road serving Ardene House Veterinary Practice /Hospital. This proposal being in the interests of road safety when considering the increased volume of traffic that will be using the access road. The convenient alternative, with the gap closed, will be the nearby Kingswells Roundabout and the AWPR/Kingswells Roundabout Junction.

FULL DETAILS OF THE ABOVE PROPOSALS ARE TO BE FOUND IN THE DRAFT ORDER, WHICH, TOGETHER WITH A MAP SHOWING THE INTENDED MEASURES AND AN ACCOMPANYING STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS, MAY BE EXAMINED DURING NORMAL OFFICE HOURS ON WEEKDAYS, BETWEEN 2 MARCH AND 24 MARCH 2020, IN THE OFFICES OF THE ROADS OFFICIALS IN THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AND ROAD SAFETY DEPARTMENT, AT MARISCHAL COLLEGE, BROAD STREET, ABERDEEN. IT'S RECOMMENDED THAT ANYONE VISITING MARISCHAL COLLEGE TO VIEW ANY OF THE DOCUMENTS SHOULD MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO DO SO, IN ORDER THAT A MEMBER OF STAFF CAN BE PRESENT TO OFFER AN EXPLANATION IF NECESSARY.
